DAIRY PLANT MATERIAL LOSS CONTROL WORKSHOP

Course Description: This course is designed to save you money by reducing material loss. Team members who have responsibility in the areas of Finance, Production, Planning, Quality Control, Sanitation, Engineering, Training, Distribution and Sales or Customer Support will find value in this course. It is designed for Dairy Plant Operations Teams. The three goals for the training are:

1. Understanding what causes losses and what controls are necessary to reduce loss.
2. Understanding what contributes to current losses in your plant.
3. Developing a loss reduction plan for your facility.

We begin with interactive training, so that each person in the plant process understands his/her affect on material control. The procedures and controls necessary to reduce and avoid losses in each area of the plant from receiving through distribution will be learned. Review of your current plant procedures and loss results are incorporated into the classes. On the last day, the class participants will develop a department by department plan to control shrink in your plant operations.

Course Duration and Location: The course is designed for 4 days of interactive training. The location will be at a meeting area in your facility or at a location close to your plant, in order to control travel time and expense.

Course Designed for: Dairy plant lead-persons, supervisors, superintendents, production managers, operations managers, distribution leadership, quality control team members, human resources and training associates, finance managers and accountants, engineering and preventive maintenance leadership, production planning and purchasing associates, and plant sales and customer support members.
